

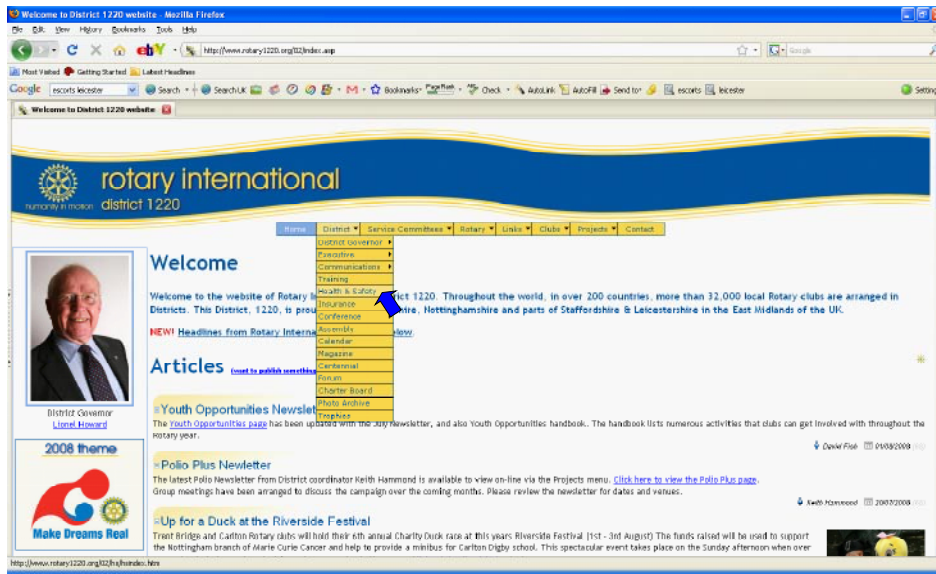

Clubs are required by RIBI, and by D1220:

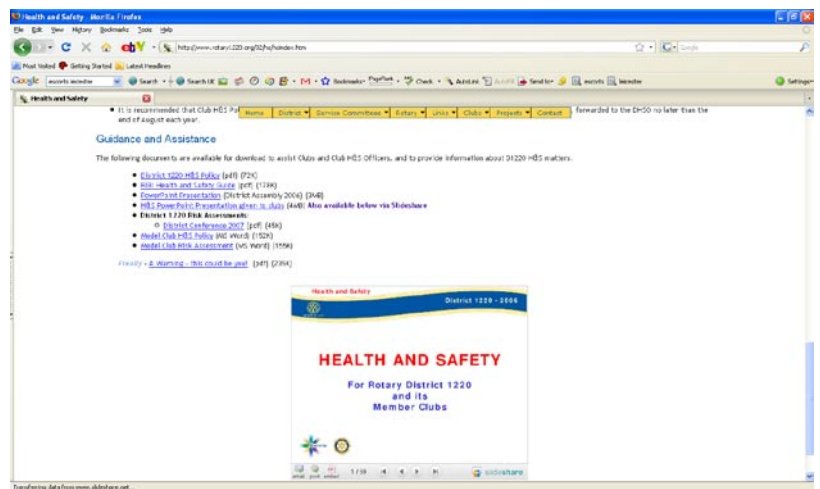
to appoint a **Club H&S Officer**,
